Squirrel pox, or squirrel fibromatosis, is an awful disease that affects squirrels.Unlike human chicken pox, squirrel pox is not a herpes virus. It is transmitted via blood, so mostly individuals contract it through biting insect vectors, such as fleas or



mosquitoes.
